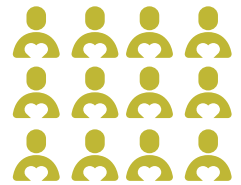

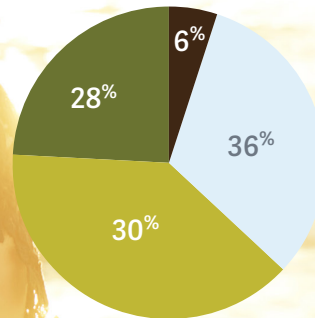

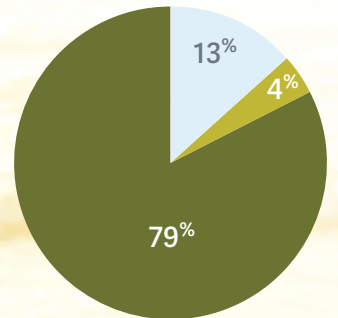

PARTICIPANT ETHNICITY



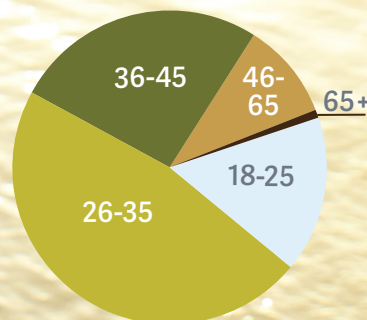

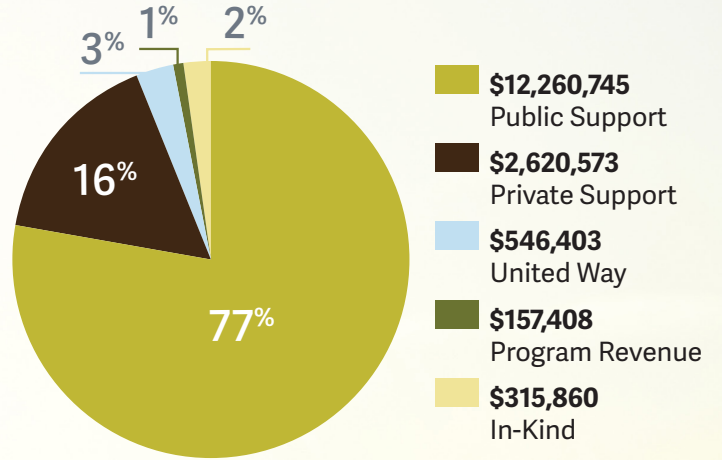
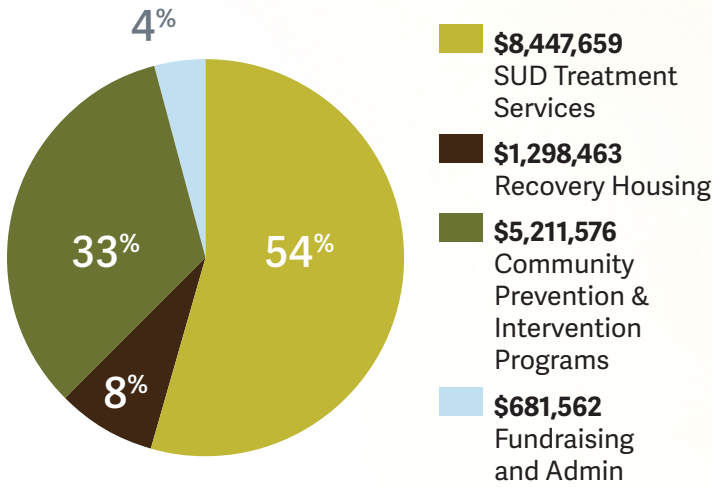
