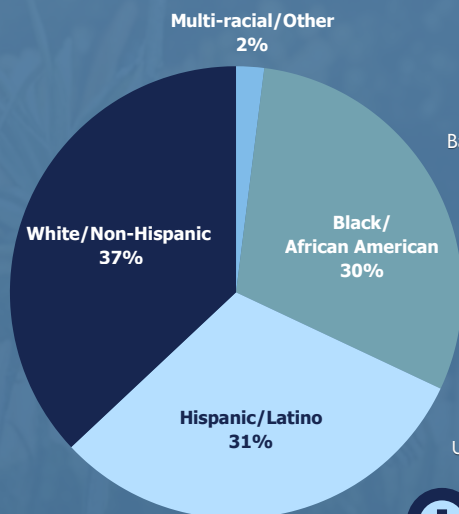

The mission of Santa Maria is to empower women and their families to lead healthy, successful, productive, and self-fulfilling lives.

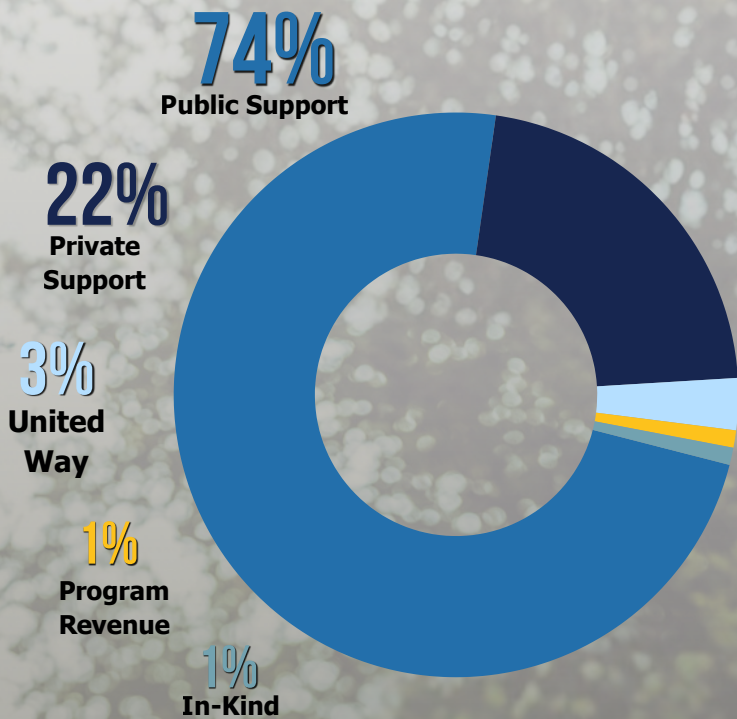


VISION

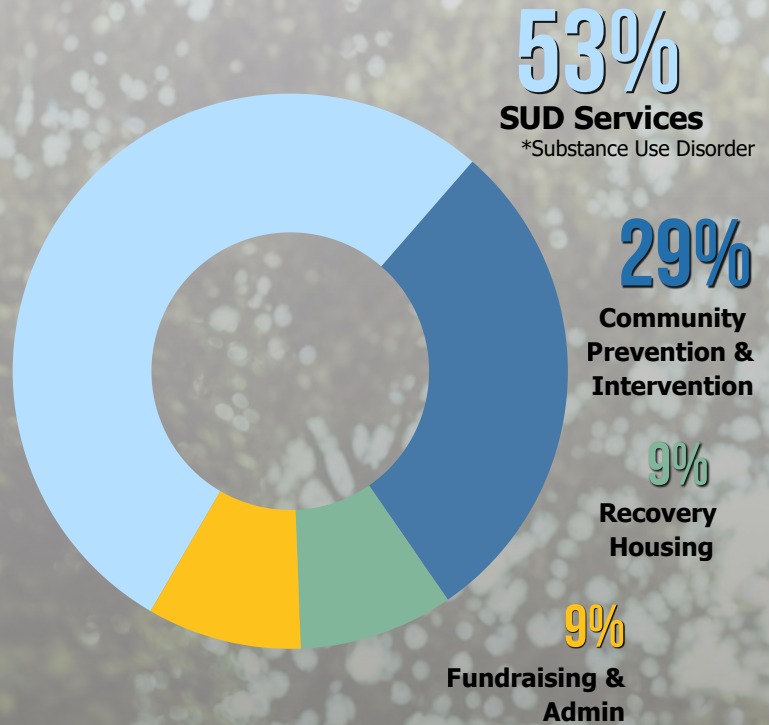
